Summer Work: Please use a single subject spiral notebook or a composition notebook to complete all of these assignments. Please keep them separated by sections: Reading, Writing, Listening and Vocabulary. All Honors Spanish students are expected to complete this work by the third day of class, August 14th. **There will also be a test over the readings and vocabulary that day.**

1. Readings:

- *Mi Propio Auto*
 - **For each chapter**
 - ◆ Read the chapter
 - ◆ Look up any unknown words using the glossary in the back or www.wordreference.com
 - ◆ Write a 2-3 sentence summary of the chapter in the PRETERITE and IMPERFECT (past) tenses.

2. Writing:

- Maintain a personal journal and record one journal entry per week. Each entry should be 75-100 words in length, written entirely in Spanish past tense (preterite only). The journal entries **must be dated and the words totaled**. The format must be consistent. You will be required to **have 8 entries**. If you feel like you don't have anything interesting that happened during the week, make it up!

3. Listening:

- Watch 2 movies with the language set to Spanish and Spanish subtitles. During each movie make a list of **50 words** (words like yo, hola etc. do not count) **in Spanish** that you recognize and **write the English** next to them too. **After the movie write a 100-150 word summary of the movie in Spanish in the past tense.**

4. Vocabulary:

Study the 50 given vocabulary words. Use each of them in a sentence which can be in any tense (present, present progressive, preterit, imperfect). Please use a variety of transition words, details and verb tenses in your sentences.

General Guidelines:

- Pay attention to grammar including: spelling, accents and noun/adjective agreement
- All writing must be legible but can be in pen, pencil or typed
- All assignments must be complete when turned in, partial work will not be accepted
- This assignment is worth 500 points. Make sure it's done on time to start your grade off in a positive manner!

5-6 Summer Vocabulary

Study the 50 given vocabulary words. Use each of them in a sentence which can be in any tense (present, present progressive, preterit, imperfect). You should have a total of 50 sentences, using each verb 1 time. **Please highlight or underline each verb.** Please have a variety of verb tenses, extra details and transition words. Remember that if a verb is stem-changer (shoe verb) its change follows the infinitive and it changes only in the present tense.

Ex: - Dormir (ue), congujates as yo duermo; tú duermes etc.
