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Les études d'été en français

Summer Work: All AP French students are expected to complete the following work by the second day of school, August 13th. In addition, there will be a test over *Ma Voiture à Moi* (write a résumé) and the vocabulary list of 30 words (French to English and sentences) on that day.

1. Readings-

a. *Ma Voiture à Moi*

For each chapter:

- Skim the chapter and write the French words that you don't know on the worksheet and write the English translation next to them;
- Read the chapter;
- Write a summary of the chapter in French (past tense) on the worksheet;
- Do the exercises in the packet that go with the chapter;
- Add to the culture page.

b. « **On a bien rigolé** » et « **Je fréquente Agnan** » (Petit Nicolas stories)

- Skim the story and write the French words that you don't know on the Petit Nicolas Worksheet and write the English translation next to them;
- Read the story;
- Complete the Petit Nicolas worksheet. The summary should be 75-100 words in French (past tense).

2. Writing-

Maintain a writing journal: Record one journal entry per week (8 total). It should be 100-150 words in length, written entirely in French. You are to choose your topics from the list and use **wordreference.com** to incorporate new vocabulary. Please underline any new vocabulary words that you use.

3. Vocabulary-

Study the 50 vocabulary words. Choose 25 words and write a sentence with each of them on the worksheet.

4. Listening –

Watch 4 French movies with the **language set to French and French subtitles**. During each movie make a list of 15 phrases in French that you recognize and write the English next to them. In addition, write 10 new words that you learned.
