

Calculating Weighted Grade Point Average

A student's Weighted GPA (WGPA) is a calculation that reflects achievement in the courses taken. The following table determines the number of grade points to assign for a course to reflect the rigor of the course work.

For example, Honors English is more advanced and more difficult than a regular English course. Even tougher yet is AP Literature, which has course work that is comparable to college-level material. To make the GPA reflect the extra work it takes to achieve high grades in more advanced courses, grade points are assigned according to the table above.
